





# **Copyrighted Christmas Songs**

Planning Christmas programs is an exciting time for your church, but it's not without stressors. Determining which Christmas songs are copyrighted and which are public domain is often at the top of this list. So how do you know the difference?

#### Public Domain Songs vs. Copyrighted Songs

Public domain songs are those you can use without the need to obtain permissions, pay royalties, or credit the original author. However, this does not apply to copyrighted arrangements of a song in the public domain.

Copyrighted songs require permission, licensing, or exemptions.

While there are traditional Christmas carols, songs, and hymns that fall in the public domain and can be used without permission in various settings, many modern arrangements and contemporary songs are copyrighted and owned by secular music publishers. The commonly held misconception that all Christmas songs are available for use without permission could prove costly to churches.

For example, public performances of Henry Wadsworth Longfellow's "I Heard the Bells on Christmas Day," written in 1863, can be sung during a Sunday morning service, streamed live online, or performed publicly.

However, Casting Crowns' rendition of "I Heard the Bells on Christmas Day," released in 2008, is a copyrighted musical arrangement requiring appropriate licensing.

### What about the Religious Service Exemption?

The <u>Religious Service Exemption</u> in U.S. Copyright law allows churches to play and perform copyrighted music during religious services; however, this exemption does NOT apply to music outside of services. The exemption also doesn't cover streaming services that include copyrighted music.

The Christmas season allows for a wide variety of opportunities outside of services to connect and engage with your congregation. From traditional Christmas programs to lighted walks through Bethlehem and synchronized music to children's performances. These types of special events and programming are not covered under the Religious Service Exemption.

To receive permission to use copyrighted songs, your church has two options:

- Go directly to the publisher or performance rights organization to obtain permission.
- Purchase a blanket license that covers the use of a catalog of songs (Note: Currently there is not a blanket license for sound recordings).

#### Blanket Licenses and Christmas Songs

The <u>PERFORMmusic Onsite Facilities License</u> provides churches and ministries within the US and its territories with a license for live performances and playing prerecorded music throughout their facilities, including satellite campuses.

The <u>WORSHIPcast Online Streaming License</u> allows churches and ministries to webcast or stream performances of copyrighted music on their websites.

These blanket licenses give your church or ministry the ability to have the worship team play, perform, or stream from your church website millions of songs, including new arrangements of favorite Christmas classics and new songs by artists such as:
